# Along the way

Haughton Chapel is a dedicated monument. It was originally the parish church of the vanished village of Haughton and was dedicated in 1257.

All Saints' West Markham is believed to be of Saxon origin. The church served as the parish church for Milton West Markham and Bevercotes until 1833.

The church was closed for regular worship and destined to be demolished by the 4<sup>th</sup> Duke of Newcastle when he built a new church and the Mausoleum at Milton. It was however, never demolished and services recommenced here at Easter in 1949.

**Milton Mausoleum** was built by Henry Pelham Clinton 4<sup>th</sup> Duke of Newcastle as a final resting place for his wife Georgiana, who died tragically young following the birth of twins. It was closed for regular service in 1949, and taken into the care of The Churches Conservation Trust in 1972.


