

## Coastal Views at Robin Hood Bay

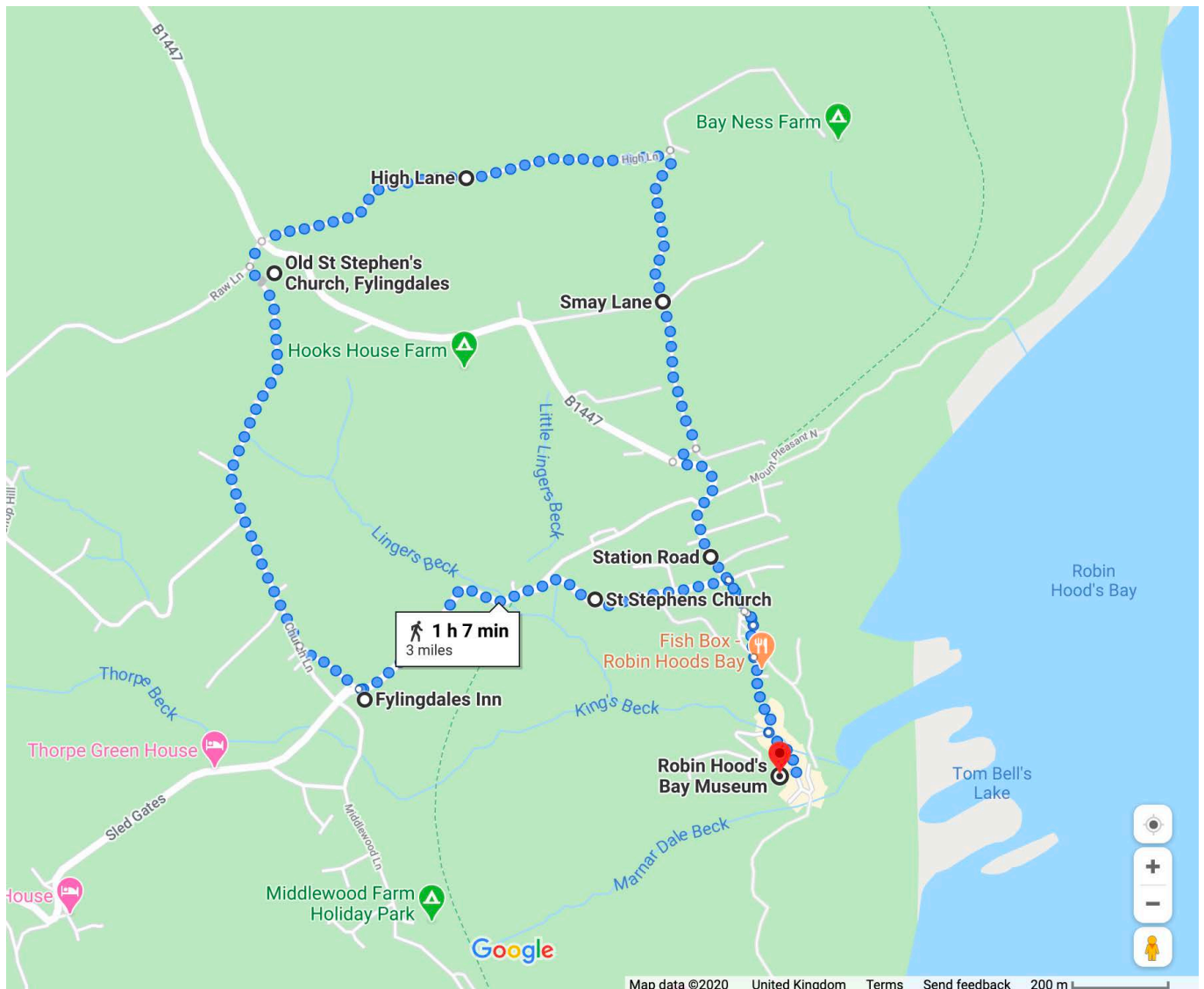
- Start point: Robin Hood's Bay Museum (Fisherhead, Robin Hood's Bay, Whitby, 4TQ)
- Route: circular
- Distance: 3 miles



### Directions

1. From Robin Hood's Bay Museum walk north on New Road
2. Continue on New Road until it merges into Station Road. Cross the roundabout and take a left onto Thorpe Lane.
3. Continue on Thorpe Lane for roughly half a mile, passing 'new' St Stephens' Church and Fyingdales Inn on the way. Then turn right into Church Lane.
4. After roughly half a mile you will come across Old St Stephens Church. If you can, why not take a moment to rest here and explore the touching memorials to the shipwrecked in the churchyard and enjoy the extraordinary views.
5. To return to the museum by the circular route, and enjoy more sea views, turn right onto raw lane when exiting the church.
6. After 200ft continue on to High Lane
7. After roughly half a mile turn right onto Smay Lane.
8. After roughly half a mile turn right at Elm Grove and then left back onto Station Road.
9. Follow Station Road and New Road back to the museum.
