## Adventures through ArChway Yarburgh Cycle Route



St. John the Baptist Yarburgh, St. Peter South Somercotes, St Botolph Skidbrooke, All Saits Saltfleetby, All Saints Theddlethorpe, St. Mary North Cockerington (Approximate distance 30 miles)

- Start at Yarburgh Church
- Exit church and take a right onto King Street, continue down this road to the A1031/Conisholme Road.
- Turn right onto A1031/Conisholme Road
- Turn right onto Barrow's Gate and continue on to Pickathorpe Lane
- At the end of the lane turn right on South Road
- Turn right onto Billings gate and Follow into south Somercotes, the church is on the right.
- Exit the church, turn out the same way and make an immediate right onto Town Street.

- Follow the road left onto East Row
- At he junction take a right-follow the sign for Skidbrooke and Saltfleetby
- At next junction bear left following the Skidbrooke, Marblethorpe sign.
- Continue down this road to a junction, the church is visible down a path.
- Exit church and continue down the same road, at junction continue following Saltfleetby and Marblethorpe sign.
- Continue straight through the next junction Swallow Gate Road,
- Turn right at T junction then bear left
- Turn left on B1200
- Take the first right on Mill Lane
- Turn right on Back Street, Church is on the right.
- Exit Church and continue in the same direction down Back Street
- Continue on Church Lane and take a left at junction, follow Great Calton and Theddlethorpe sign

- Take first left down Thacker Bank and continue 2 miles, church is on the left
- Exit church and back track on Thacker Bank and take a right at first junction
- At the next junction go straight and follow the Manby and Grimoldby sign.
- Go straight across the B1200/ Mar Dyke west to North End Lane
- At junction bear left and follow the North Cockerington sign
- Take a sharp right, no sign to follow
- Take a right onto Back Lane
- At Grange Lane junction bear left to Chapel Lane
- Continue onto Lock road
- At T junction turn right
- Bear right onto Church Lane, church is on the right
- Exit church and backtrack on Church lane and bear right
- Turn left onto Yarburgh road and follow back to Yarburgh
